REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

The township board met at the town hall for it's regular monthly meeting with the following board members present: Peter Clay, Roger McNear, Bill Friedland, Lou Westberg, and Michelle Kleven. Clay called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Kleven read the June regular monthly minutes. Clay made a motion to approve the monthly minutes. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. Kleven also read the minutes from Rights of Way hearing and the Special meeting held on June 30th, 2004. Friedland made a motion to approve the Rights of Way minutes, McNear seconded the motion. Motion carried. Clay made a motion to approve the special meeting minutes. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER REPORT: Westberg read the current treasurers report. Clay made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: McNear read the current claims and payroll for the month. Friedland made a motion to approve the claims. Clay seconded the motion. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: McNear read the updated clean up day memo sent to the Isanti County Zoning office. Clay will confirm any sewer workshops in Isanti County. Tiede to send a letter to Eddy Wilkinson regarding his driveway expiring and not paying for his culvert. The board also discussed when driveway permits close to expiring, Kleven will send out letters of driveway expiration notices and will also keep an updated copy of all driveway permits and send out to keep board members updated. Kleven will research interest rates for loans related to paving West Briar 2nd addition. Clay made a motion to order the hearing on improvement and preparation of plans for West Briar 2nd addition. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. Kleven will post and publish the hearing. Secretary of State has granted Springvale Township a grant for fixing up the townhall for upcoming elections. McNear agreed to fix the entrance ramp, Friedland agreed to order and put up new signs, and Clay agreed to work on the Threshold entrance. The board discussed memos sent from MnDot regarding Highway 47 construction.

NEW BUSINESS: Kleven attended Auditor meeting on 6/17/04 for election updates. Copies of memos sent by Deb Peterson were distributed to all board members. Friedland and Clay to set a weed inspection date with Deb Peterson. Tiede to contact Kuznar's attorney Clark Joslin regarding access from Springvale Township road Zeon Street and permission from neighboring property owners. McNear made a motion to accept Kuznar's turnaround proposal. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. The board read the updated memo from Richard Hansen and Mel Larson from L & R meetings held 6/7 & 6/8/04 in Willmar.

ROADS: Steve Hass updated the board on town roads. The board also gave Hass permission to grade the chloride roads. The board will get up new signs by the end of September.
