REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING

The township board met at the town hall for it's regular monthly meeting with the following board members present: Peter Clay, Bill Friedland, Lou Westberg, and Michelle Kleven. Clay called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Kleven read the May regular monthly minutes. Friedland made a motion to approve the minutes. Clay seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER REPORT: Westberg read the current treasurers report. Friedland made a motion to approve the treasurer's report. Clay seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: Clay read the current claims and payroll for the month. Friedland made a motion to approve the claims. Clay seconded the motion. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: Clay updated the board on the unofficial detour request for construction on Highway 47 north of Highway 95. Blackfoot Street would need at least 500 more cars traveled per day to even receive a partial return of maintenance costs. The board decided not to pursue Blackfoot Street as a detour at this time. Clay read the updated driveway permit checklist. Kleven to add after 120 days expiration date information to the driveway permit. Clay made a motion to approve the cost of \$100.00 to record Kleven's notary commission with the County. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

New Deputy Clerk is Sally Shugren. Kleven has set up a payment plan for Brent Mattfield's \$200.00 fire call fee due. Mattfield will pay \$50.00 per month for the next 4 months. No updates on Cambridge Auto Salvage, McNear waiting for response from Tiede. Start working on weed policy in July. Kleven to send letters to all expiring driveway permit owners and notify them the Township will be inspecting and if not finished correctly the owner will fix at their expense or reapply for another permit. Clay made a motion to accept the turn back of R/W on Roanoke Road and Hwy 47. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. State of MN (Secretary of State) has awarded Springvale Township \$750.00 from the Help America Vote Grant..

ROADS:

Hass updated the board on roads. Chloride has been sprayed on all roads planned. Board will get new signs up in the next couple of months.
