PUBLIC HEARING AND REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES**

The township board met at the town hall for the public hearing On proposed assessment to West Briar 2nd addition with the following board members present: Peter Clay, Roger McNear, Bill Friedland, and Michelle Kleven. McNear called the hearing to order at 7:03 pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Brian Miller from BDM discussed and presented the project in detail to all town residents in attendance at the hearing. McNear asked for any further discussion from the audience. McNear will notify Richard Hansen of Bradford township of Springvale township's decision on moving ahead with the project. Clay made a motion to take the bid and move ahead. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. No appeals were heard.

NEW BUSINESS: Friedland and Deb Petersen inspection the township for weeds on August 4th, 2004. Weed control looked under control. Kleven relayed a request from John Cosgrove at Access information Systems to receive personal information about one of West Briars residents. The board decided this was a County issue and inform Mr. Cosgrove to contact the Isanti County Auditor. Friedland met with the Election ballot machine company at the townhall on August 12th to make sure the ballot box and machine were working properly. Friedland also attended the Bauerly open house on August 24th and brought some useful information back to the town board. McNear will fill out Park survey and mail.

ROADS: Steve Hass updated the board on town roads. McNear and Clay will do a fall road inspection September 18th at 8:00am. Steve Hass will join them. Kuznar's turnaround is finished. Friedland and McNear will start fixing and replacing signs on September 2nd.
