Fall road inspection.

The inspection of the township Roads was performed by Peter Clay and Roger McNear.

We inspected the request for a stop sign on 329th street and Heather Street. Our conclusion was that a sign be placed showing Tee road and on that signed also stating blind intersection.

We inspected a culvert at 198 341st avenue. A new call for has been placed and it is a black plastic covert this does not meet the township specifications for Culverts. Therefore we will request the clerk to notify the owner of the property that the caller was to be replaced with a 12in. by 30' culvert as per our specifications.

At the corner of 341st and Holly there should be a load of gravel added to raise that corner. Just and west of that corner there is a small dead tree in the right of way which should be removed. Further to the west a fallen tree on the Richard Olsen property is in the right of way Roger we'll call Rick.

On township road 345th E. east of highway number one there is any low spot between two ponds which should have a load of gravel at the area of muskrat holes.

On 349th there is a shed which was built in the township right of way, it's possible that the shed had at one time belonged to the township for road maintenance, we would as the clerk to check the abstract of the landowner to see if it's possible to find if there's still a township liability to the shed.

It on inspection we find that the Dale Anderson farm has the crops wanted in the right of way on 357th and on Blackfoot street. In accordance with the road right of way ordinance crops may not be planted within the road right of way and a copy of the ordinance with the area highlighted should be sent to Mr. Anderson explaining that we will not pursue legal action this year however if the crops were planted there again next year that we will remove those crops from the right of way and bill him for that removal.

On Flamingo street south of county road six Douglas Fredeen farm as a steel posted a fence in the right of way and he has dumped brush and traffic within the right away and Bernd said trash. We should send him notification that he has a set period of time to be determined at the township meeting to remove the said and clean up the brush and trash from the right of way if within that period of time he has not taken the actions township shall hire someone to remove trash and relocate Fence and bill him for that.

On township road 357th west of Blackfoot street to the west of new driveway by the Bucks residents there is a parent do driveway in the process of being built a need to check our records to see the permit has been polled as per our inspection it is obviously too high to the road.

We did a drive through inspection of 328th and Magnolia Street and found that in that development there are several driveways that do not comply with the present driveway ordinance.

We discussed a procedure and a form that should be filled out at the time of final inspection for the driveways we believe that the township should purchase some type possibly a laser level to measure the elevation of the driveways in comparison to the township road. All measurements should be taken and recorded on this form before the final approval of new driveways is accepted.
