

**SPRINGVALE TOWNSHIP
HEARING ON IMPROVEMENT FOR MAYWOOD ESTATES
NOVEMBER 2, 2005**

The township board met at the town hall for a feasibility study hearing on improvement for Maywood Estates with the following board members present: Peter Clay, Roger McNear, Bill Friedland, and Michelle Kleven.
