REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

The township board met at the town hall for its regular monthly meeting with the following board members present: Roger McNear, Bill Friedland, Peter Clay, Marge Jendro, and Michelle Kleven. Clay called the meeting to order at 6:30p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: McNear made a motion to approve the June monthly meeting minutes. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. Friedland made a motion to approve the hearing minutes from June 15th, 2006. McNear seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER REPORT: Jendro read the treasurer report. McNear made a motion to approve the June treasurer's report. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: Clay read the current claims and payroll for the month. McNear made a motion to approve the claims #693-712 in the amount of \$23884.98 and payroll for \$3,411.08. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

GOPHER BOUNTY: No gopher bounty.

OLD BUSINESS: Brian Miller from BDM engineering gave the board an update on project status in Springvale Township. Woodland Hills-Jim Ryberg's plat has its first lift of blacktop, BDM will be working with survey crews on Bob Towler's project by the middle of July, Miller will send a letter to Keith Fluth to remind him of the time limit with the developer's agreement to get the first lift of blacktop down and right of ways seeded, and Miller has heard nothing new on the Becklin/Steve Nelson road. Put on the August agenda, letter for bid bond from Green Meadows. Residents along 361st Avenue NW were present to talk about the upgrade and consent form for tree removal- Ray Pepin, Stuart Coleman, and Glenn Lood. Clay explained the township will only make 361st Avenue NW a minimum maintenance road passable and Hass will work with the residents to assure all is understood before any work will be done. Clay will meet with Larry Sutherland to sign the consent for tree removal and waiver to trespass forms to work on Vale Street NW. The ditch policy was tabled until August. The township website was tabled until August. Kleven to draft a letter to Steve Lindgren regarding his bushes in the right of way. Clay brought some statues regarding right of way safety. Kleven will send draft to Clay for final approval. A letter was sent to the Isanti County Sportsmen's Club in June pertaining to projectiles leaving their property and the township requested what action is being taken to prevent this from happening in the future.

NEW BUSINESS: Melissa Jabas spoke to the town board and residents regarding her campaign. Jendro talked about four wheelers in the right of way of Highway 95 and what could the township do to help fix the problem. Clay will bring some information to the August meeting.

ROADS: Dustcoating was finished in June. Friedland went on a weed inspection in June and all looked good for Springvale Township. Glenn Lood started mowing the ditches this week. Clay signed the town line road agreements for Cambridge and Bradford Township's. Kleven will mail the town line road agreements out to them this week. Kleven to send right a letter to Randy Friez regarding his fence post(s) in the right of way.
