REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

The township board met at the town hall for its regular monthly meeting with the following board members present: Roger McNear, Bill Friedland, Marge Jendro, and Michelle Kleven. McNear called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Friedland made a motion to approve the February meeting minutes. McNear seconded the motion. Motion carried

APPROVAL OF TREASURER REPORT: Jendro read the treasurer report. Friedland made a motion to approve the February treasurer's report. McNear seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: McNear read the current claims and payroll for the month. Friedland made a motion to approve the claims. McNear seconded the motion. Motion carried.

GOPHER BOUNTY: Caleb Sweedeen brought in 71 gophers. Kleven to mail a check in the amount of \$124.25.

OLD BUSINESS: Jim Ryberg not present with Developer's agreement for Woodland Hills. McNear read Resolution for Maywood and Green Meadows Hearing on proposed assessments. McNear made a motion to approve resolutions 4 & 5 for Maywood Estates and Green Meadows 2006 road improvement hearing on proposed assessments. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. Brian Miller to note that no swing mailboxes were noted in the bids for road improvements and the town board would like all mailboxes to be swing away on new road constructions per the Springvale Township road ordinance. 2006 road improvement assessment hearing scheduled for March 23rd, 2006 at 6:30 p.m. at the town hall. McNear went over the subdivision ordinance draft. Brian Miller will look over the draft and note we do not have a town surveyor. The subdivision ordinance hearing is scheduled for April 11th, 2006 at 6:30 p.m. The ditch policy draft will be discussed at the April meeting.

NEW BUSINESS: No board members attended the Cambridge Fire meeting. Kleven received information from both Dalbo and Cambridge Fire departments with the 2007 contracts for the Annual meeting. The Reorganizational meeting will be scheduled for April 11th, 2006 following the subdivision ordinance hearing. The spring road evaluation will be scheduled for April 15th, 2006 starting at 8:00 a.m. Minnco CD up for renewal 3/12/06. McNear made a motion to have Kleven handle the renewal and find the best interest rate. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. Residents were concerned with Peter Clay's attendance the past few months. The board discussed and decided to have Kleven send a letter about the concern from residents.

ROADS: McNear and Miller had no updates on Becklin Park to build a road for the township. Road Maintenance bids are to be opened 3/26/06 at 6:00 p.m. Kleven and McNear will attend this bid opening. Kleven read the memos from Ziegler and A-1 paving companies. The "T" sign (double arrow) is bent at University and 341st.
