

**SPRINGVALE TOWNSHIP  
JUNE 4, 2008  
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES**

The township board met at the town hall for its regular monthly meeting with the following board members present: Roger McNear, Bill Friedland, Burt Coleman, Marge Jendro, and Michelle Kleven. McNear called the meeting to order at 6:31pm. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Friedland made a motion to approve the May monthly meeting minutes. Coleman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**APPROVAL OF TREASURER REPORT:** Jendro read the treasurer report. Friedland made a motion to approve the May treasurer's report. Coleman seconded the motion. Motion carried. Friedland made a motion to transfer \$4,352.72 from the road and bridge fund to the Becklin County fund to zero out the negative balance. Coleman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**APPROVAL OF BILLS:** McNear read the current claims and payroll for the month. Friedland made a motion to approve the claims #1162 through #1175 in the amount of \$26,981.04 and payroll for \$1,920.43. Coleman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**GOPHER BOUNTY:** Derek Voss brought in 17 pairs of gopher feet and was given check #998 in the amount of \$42.50.

**ENGINEERING:** Bob Towler private road documents have been reviewed by Peter Tiede. All Towler documents have been copied, filed in the township records, and sent to Towler's attorney for recording with Isanti County

**OLD BUSINESS:** The Town Board set the ATV/ORV Ordinance hearing for June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2008 at 6:30 p.m. Kleven to check and see if the date will work with Peter Tiede to be present. Darby and Dorcus Bunnell have their new mailbox posts set and have paid half of the cost. Coleman made a motion to accept Peter Tiede recommendations to update the developer's agreement. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. Kleven to work with Tiede on updating the current developer's agreement.

**NEW BUSINESS:** No current updates on the wetland filled on the Zerfoss property off of 349<sup>th</sup> Avenue. McNear will check with Wayne Anderson to see if there are any updates. Kleven notified the board of dental insurance premiums increasing August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008. Kleven to contact Anderson-Passe, Don Hansen, and County Zoning to remind them Springvale Township reviews all plats, even if they do not have roads.

**ROADS:** Friedland is in the process of finding contractors to do crack filling on the paved township roads and processing a pavement maintenance schedule. No update from Burt Coleman regarding the consent of tree removal form to be signed by Stewart Coleman. McNear will try and contact Stewart Coleman. Mag-Chloride should be placed the third week of June. Dean Yerigan has also requested Mag-Chloride to be placed in front of his property and will pay the charges. Friedland made a motion to have Mag-Chloride placed on University Avenue NW now that no fill will be added and Cambridge Township will pay 50% of the cost. Coleman seconded the motion. Motion carried. McNear brought to the boards attention of trucks hauling and more traffic on 349<sup>th</sup> Avenue NW connecting Highway 47. Coleman made a motion to apply Mag-Chloride to the one mile stretch of 349<sup>th</sup> Avenue NW connecting to Highway 47. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. Coleman made a motion to replace Rhoda Anderson's old culvert with a 15 x 40 culvert off of Flamingo Street NW and the township will not be responsible for replacing the pavement removed to do so. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. The board will work on putting up the new signs in June.

**COMMUNICATION:**

July 18<sup>th</sup>, 2008 is the Summer Short Course in St. Cloud. Kleven went over all township mail received. ATV/ORV Ordinance Hearing on June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2008.

**PUBLIC FORUM:** Kevin Schulk requested help to get a petition signed by township residents for DSL. He asked if a request could be placed on the township website and put in the township newsletter.
