

**SPRINGVALE TOWNSHIP
JUNE 3, 2009
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES**

The township board met at the town hall for its regular monthly meeting with the following board members present: Bill Friedland, Burt Coleman, Marge Jendro, and Michelle Kleven. Not present: Roger McNear. Friedland called the meeting to order at 6:31pm. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Coleman made a motion to approve the June 3, 2009 meeting agenda. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Coleman made a motion to approve the May monthly meeting minutes. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER REPORT: Kleven read the treasurer's report. Friedland made a motion to approve the May treasurer's report. Coleman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: Kleven read the current claims and payroll for the month. Coleman made a motion to approve the claims #1401 through #1418 in the amount of \$9,322.14 and payroll for \$1,703.79. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

GOPHER BOUNTY: Doug Bergloff's grandson presented the board with 93 pairs of gopher feet and was issued check #1014 in the amount of \$232.50.

NEW BUSINESS: Friedland still has not heard when the Noxious weed inspections will be started for Springvale Township. Local Board of Appeal training available- Friedland certified and expires 7/10/2010, Coleman certified and expires 7/9/2011 and McNear not certified. OLD BUSINESS: Friedland moved the motor bike track issue, Dalbo Fire Department, and Road assessment policy update to the July 1st 2009 town meeting because McNear was not present. Coleman made a motion to accept the town hall chimney repair quote in the amount of \$1,840.00 from B. J. Baas Builders, Inc. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. B. J. Baas also gave a proposal on repairing and updating the Wheelchair ramp to state code in the amount of \$12,518.00. The town board will discuss the ramp at the July meeting. Coleman made a motion to approve having a board member sign a contract or paperwork needed to get the chimney done if not able to do so at a town meeting. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

ROADS: Friedland did some research on crack filling and will be using the same contractor that did it for Springvale Township in 2008. Mag. Chloride is tentatively scheduled for June 13th, 2009. Friedland also contacted the State Highway department to have 329th counted prior to the bridge repairs on Highway 95 to see if there would be any impact during construction.

COMMUNICATION: Township mail received. June 10th, 2009 is the Comprehensive Plan meeting. July 13th, 2009 Township Officers Summer Short Course in St. Cloud.

PUBLIC FORUM: Gordon Hillstad was present and requested getting paid for shooting beaver. Friedland explained that he was not hired to do that job. Hillstad also wanted justification as to why all board members including the clerk need to go on the Spring road inspection meeting and to pay them all. Hass and the town board explained and discussed this issue to Hillstad. Norris Shugren has some road questions and they were discussed. Shugren also was concerned that the residents of Springvale Township should all be notified of any major changes in ordinances and comprehensive plans. Kleven stated she would recommend that notification to all town residents should be done if there could be a major change in current ordinances or comprehensive plans. Shugren also notified the board that he invited Tim Anderson of Isanti County Zoning to attend the June 10th, 2009 comprehensive meeting. Kleven will verify that he will be attending and also invite Larry Southerland our district county commissioner.

Friedland made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:20 PM. Coleman seconded the motion. Motion carried.
