

**SPRINGVALE TOWNSHIP
NOVEMBER 4, 2009
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES**

The township board met at the town hall for its regular monthly meeting with the following board members present: Bill Friedland, Burt Coleman, Marge Jendro, and Michelle Kleven. Friedland called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Friedland made a motion to approve the October monthly meeting minutes. Coleman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER REPORT: Jendro read the treasurer's report. Coleman made a motion to approve the October treasurer's report. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. The Market Value Credit check came this week from the State of MN.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: Coleman made a motion to approve the claims #1503 through #1516 in the amount of \$22,475.99 and payroll for \$1,568.66. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried.

GOPHER BOUNTY: Friedland made a motion to approve paying Michelle Kleven for four pairs of gopher feet , \$10.00 claim #1517. Coleman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS: Cambridge Fire Report was read by Kleven. There was a wild land fire at Highway 95 near PineBrook. Total acres burned 1.5.

OLD BUSINESS: Kleven sent in the EAID grant application to the Secretary of State. Isanti County approved the variance request to rebuild the handicap access. The final draft of the developer's agreement was tabled for approval until the December meeting.

ROADS: Updates were given regarding the Walbo and County Road 6 bridge construction. Coleman made a motion not to publish the snow plow policy in the County News, just post at the town hall. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. Hass will be working on culverts in November. Signs to be replaced and ordered- Quapaw and 341th Lane.

COMMUNICATION: Friedland read Isanti County Zoning minutes pertaining to Springvale Township. Coleman made a motion to send a township officer to represent Springvale Township at the November 12th, 2009 Isanti County meeting. Friedland seconded the motion. Motion carried. Kleven discussed township mail reviewed. Nov. 19-21 Annual MAT Conference in Rochester.
