New Business

County Transit: Board discussed sending a letter to Emmet County Commissioners and Mike Reeves that the township is NOT in support of a Transit Authority in Emmet County. Pat McCune made the motion that a letter to that effect be composed by Supervisor McCune, seconded by Dawn DeRue. All in favor.

Change Board Meeting Start Time: Pat McCune made a motion to change Board Meeting start time to 7:00 PM, seconded by Dawn DeRue, all in favor.

Road Signs: A) Channel Road signs—Bid from Road Traffic Safety Corp. at \$3,930.00 for 2 signs with flashing lights. Motion made by Becky Fettig to accept Channel Road signs according to the drawings and order two of the larger size, Pat McCune seconded. All agreed. B) “Blind Drive” signs—2 will be ordered to be installed along Mitchell Road.

Subterranean H2O storage tank, Joy Cemetery: DJ Service Ellsworth \$7,000.00
Northern Pump Service, Inc. \$38,487.88

Kyle Ulrich made the motion to accept the DJ Service Ellsworth bid, Pat McCune seconded, Roll call vote: all in favor.

Emmet County Equalization Dept.: Assessor has requested that she be able to put parcel documentation on the Emmet County Web site. This will cost \$0.10 per parcel to equal about \$170/one time cost. Board had additional questions. Supervisor McCune will bring back information for discussion at May Board meeting.
